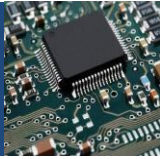

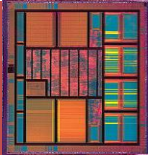
What is TexasWISE?

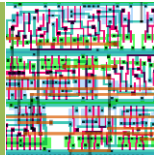
Goals of the Poster Session
